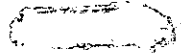

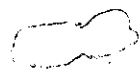

Fall 1965



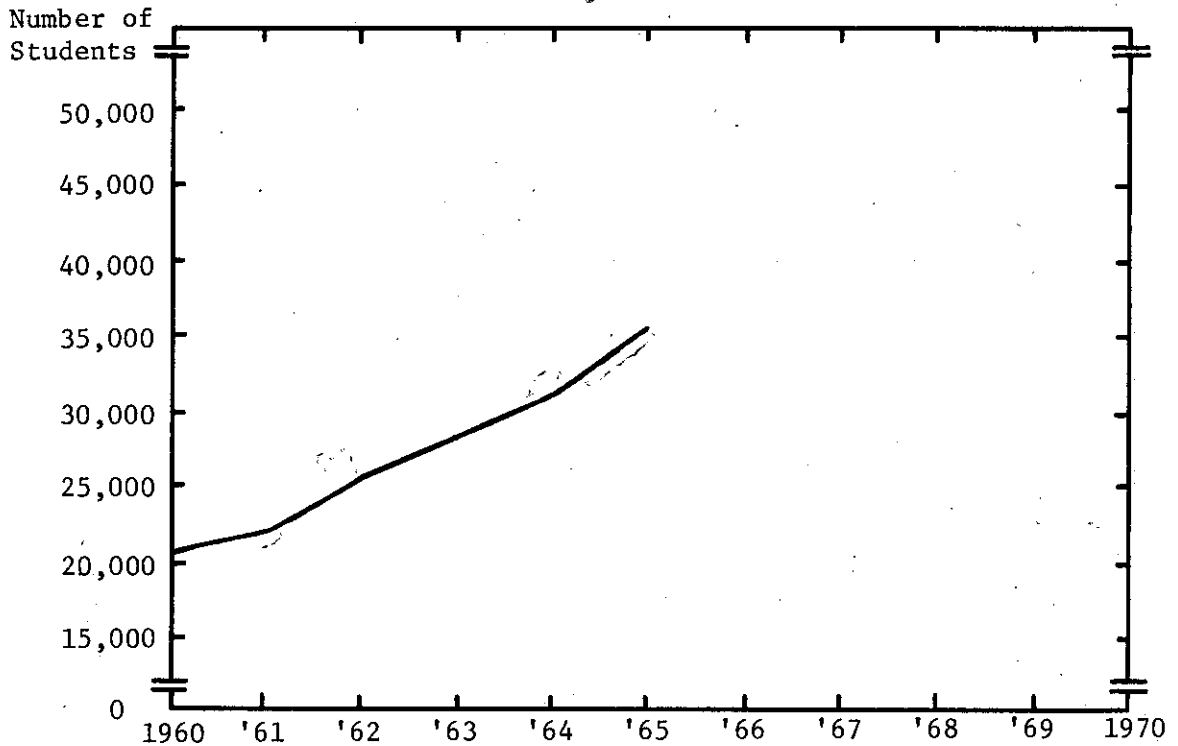

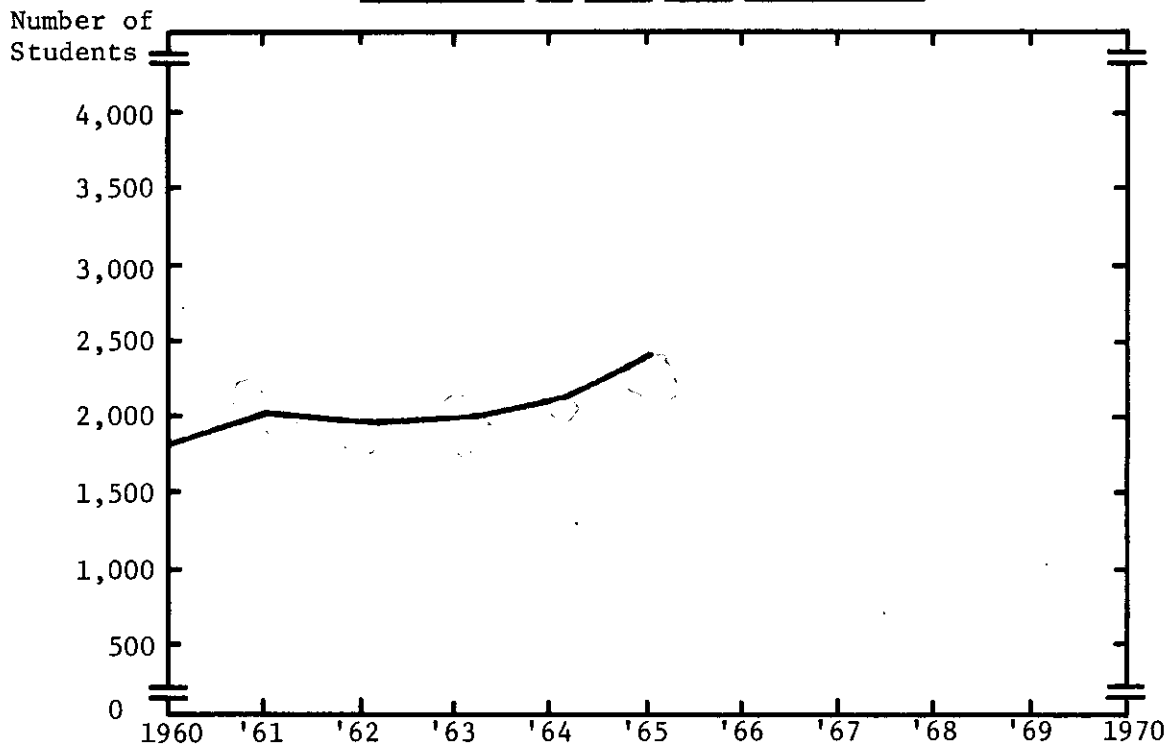

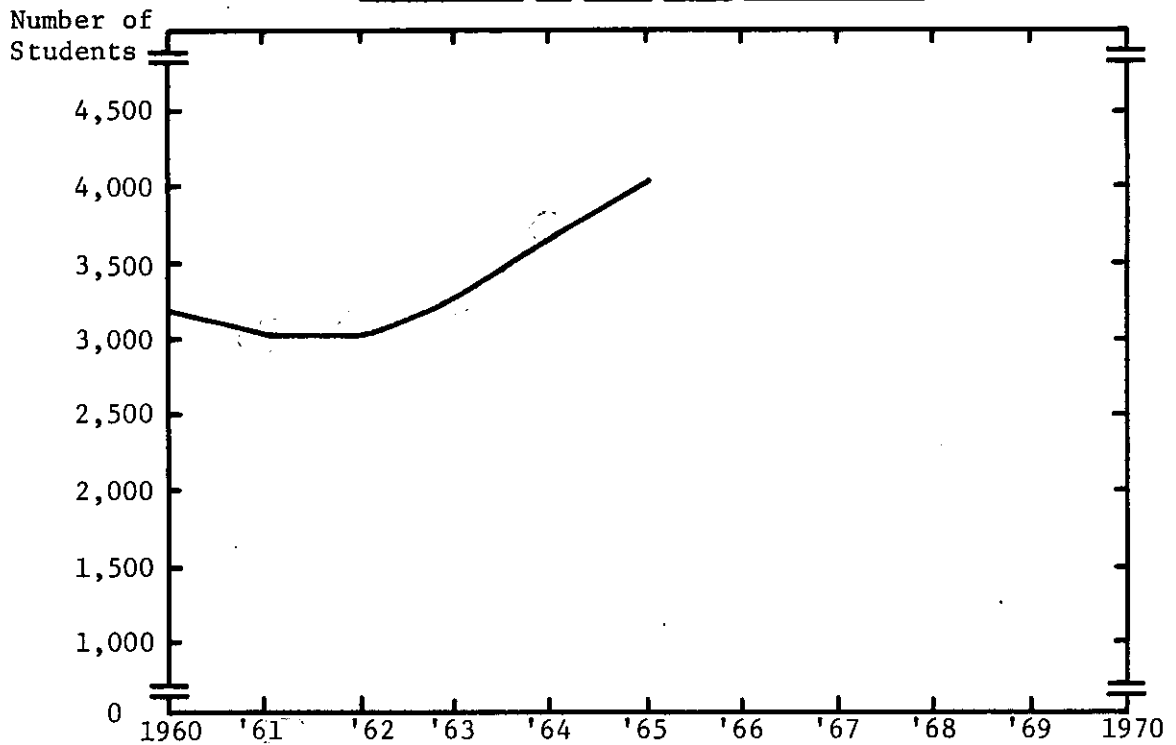

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



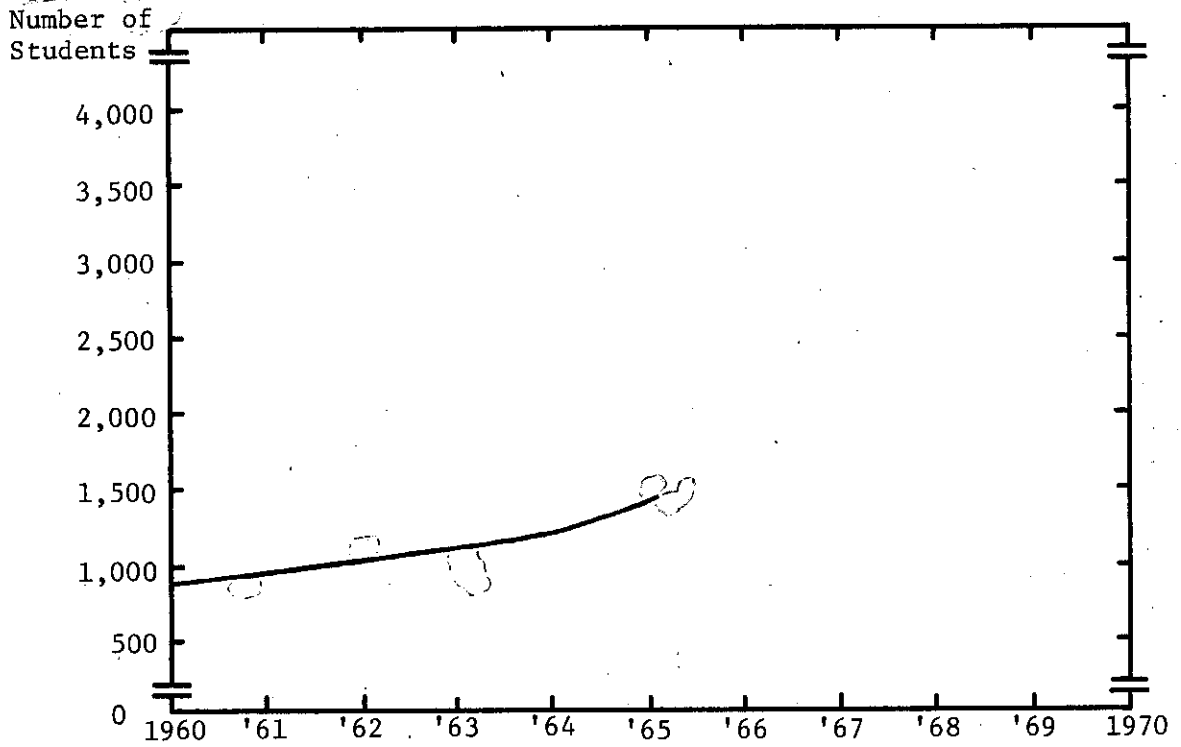

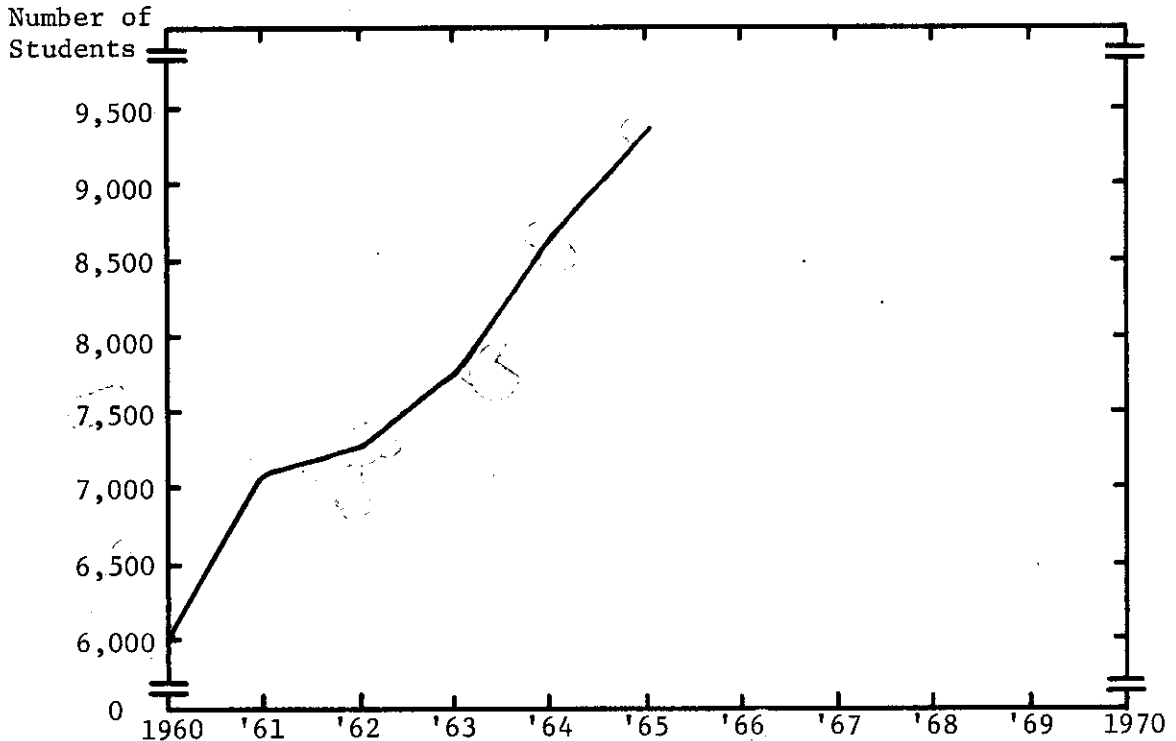

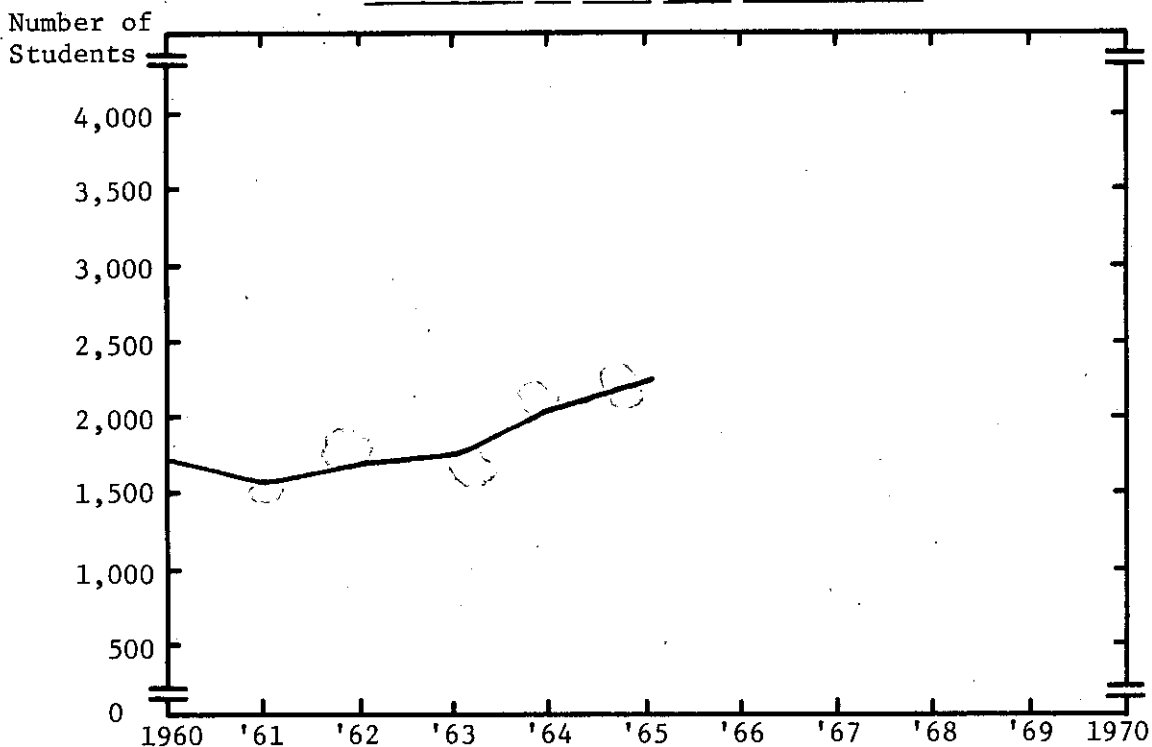

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



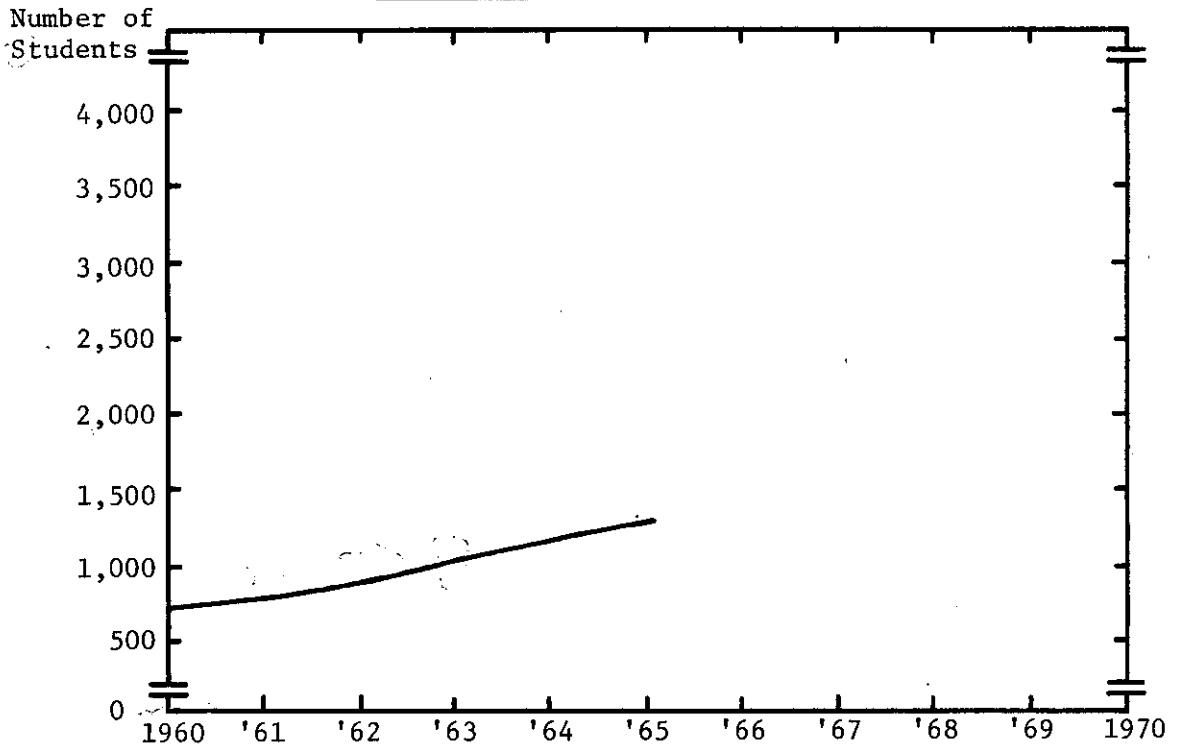

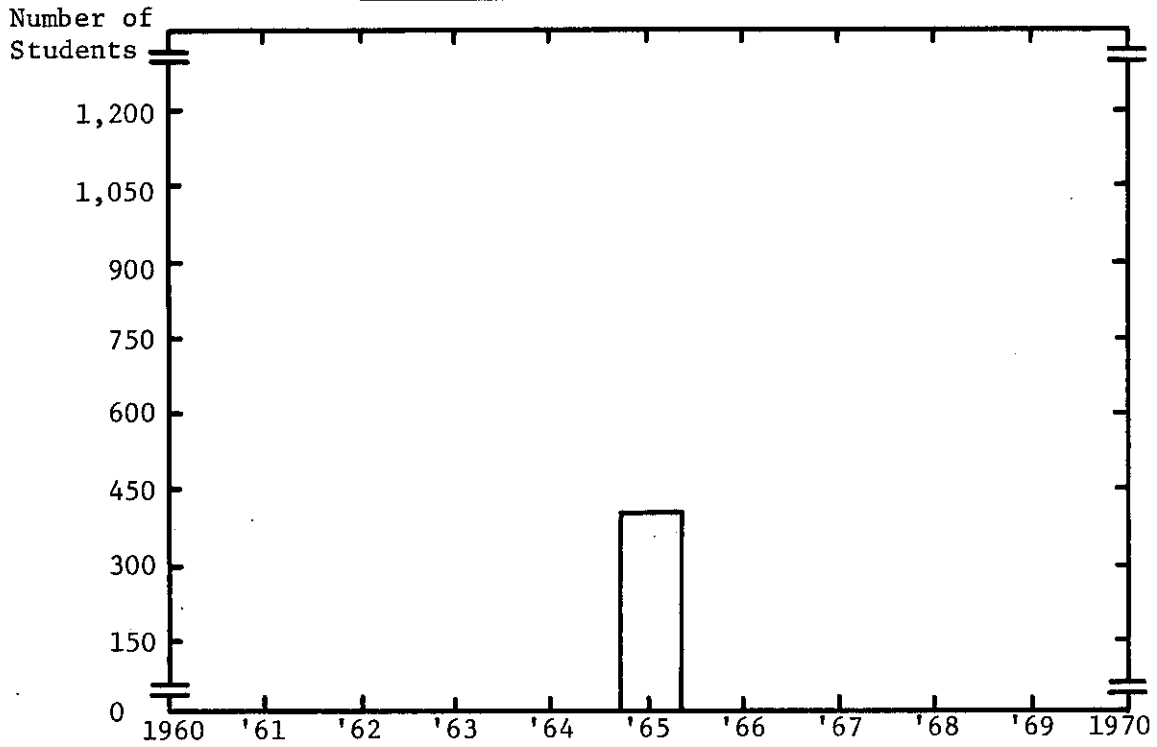

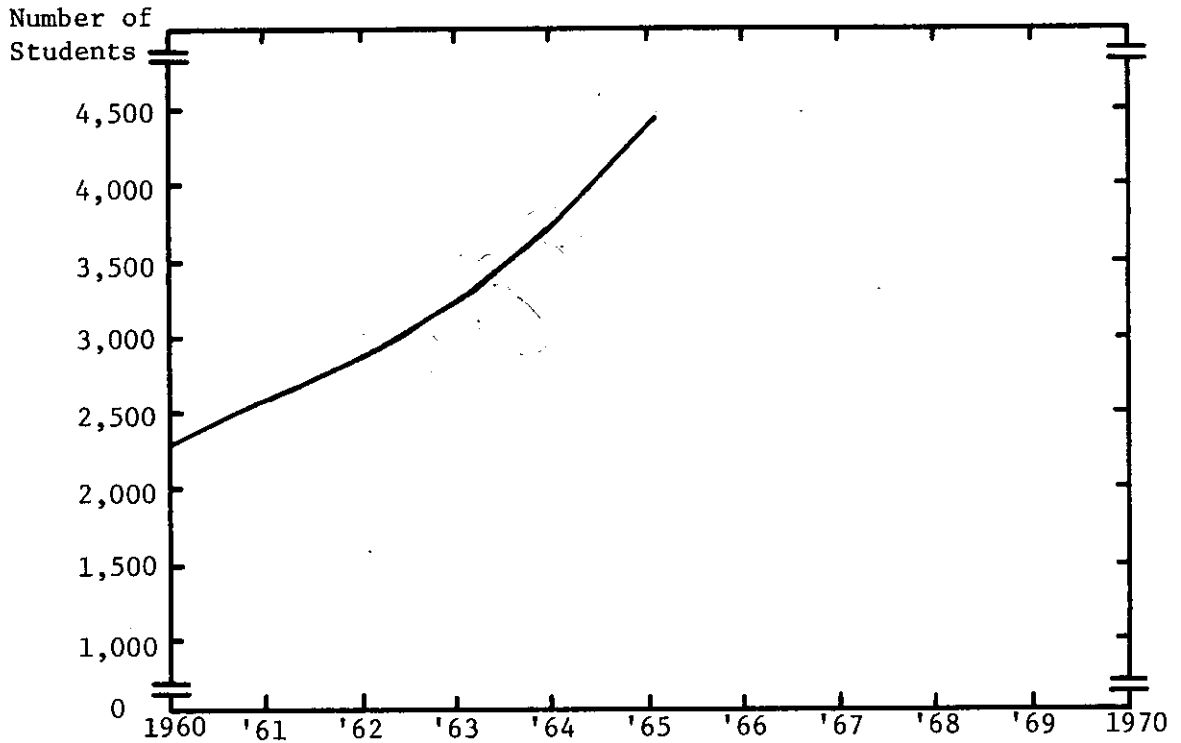

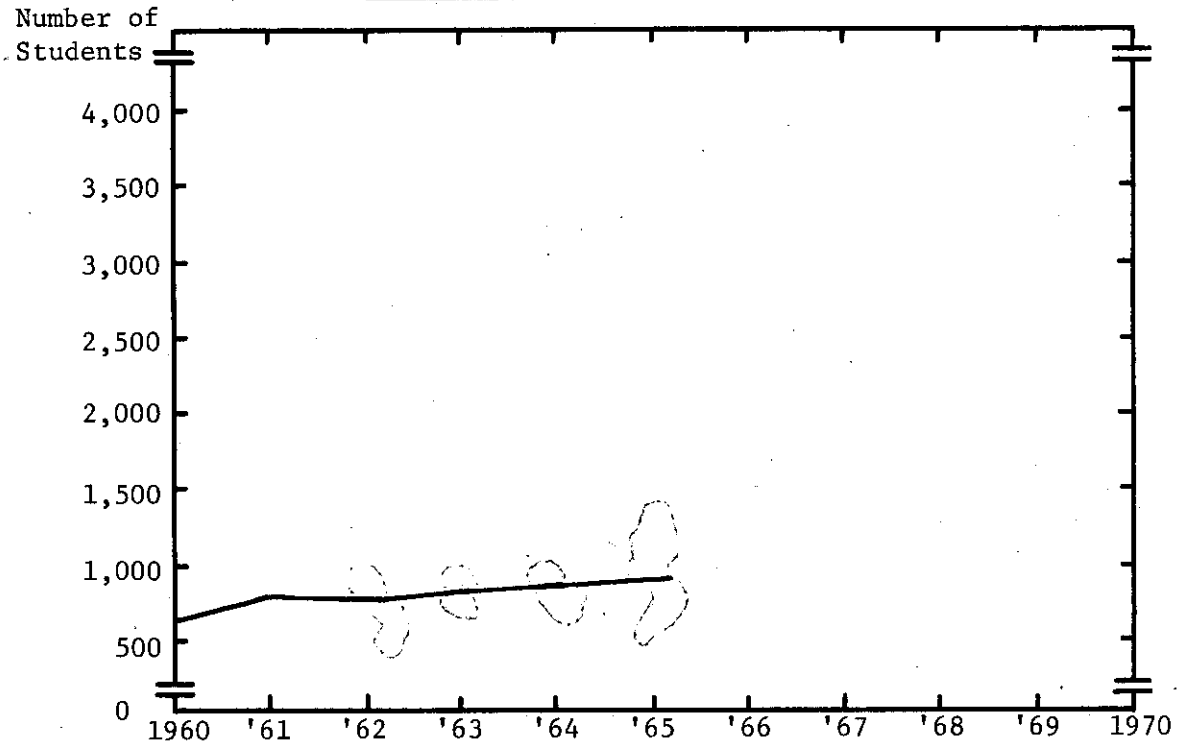
