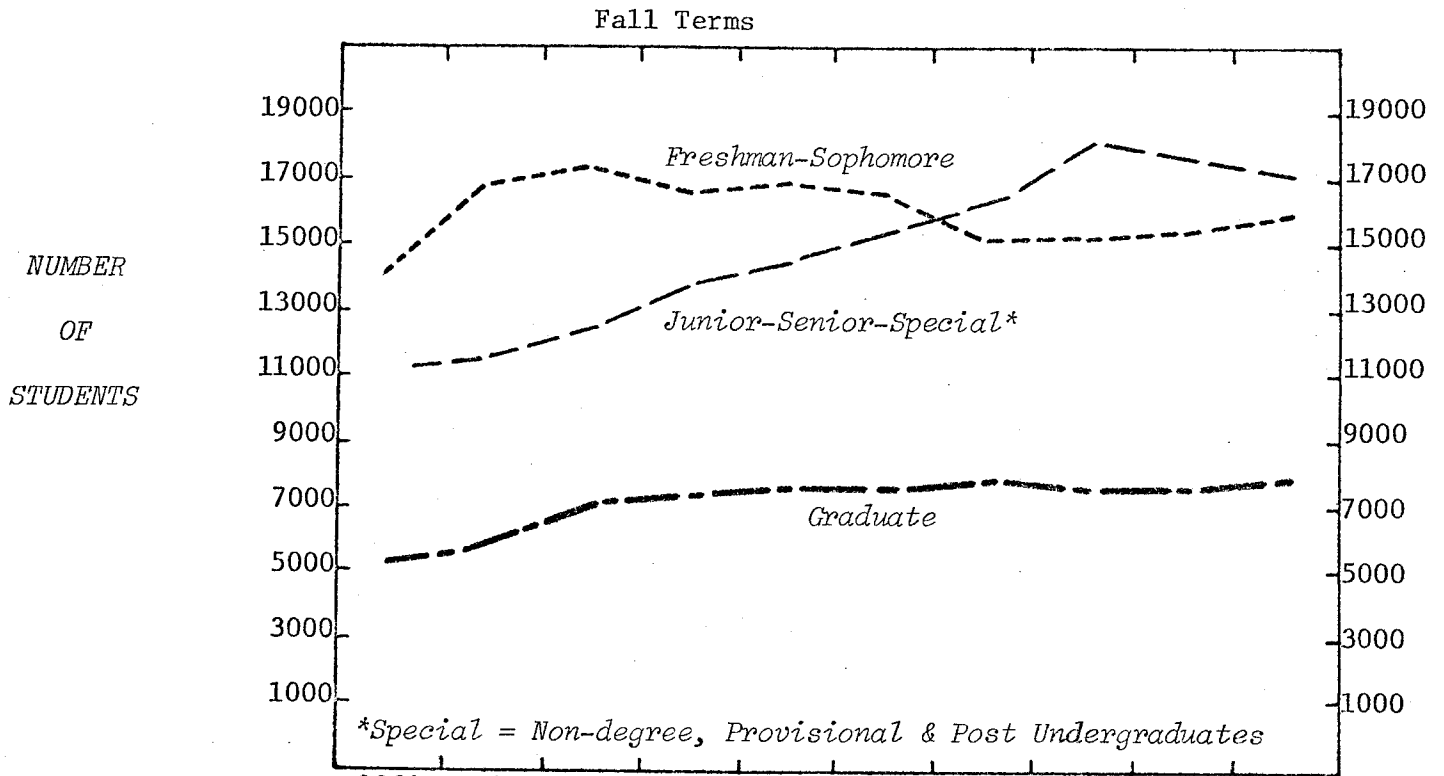

East Lansing Campus



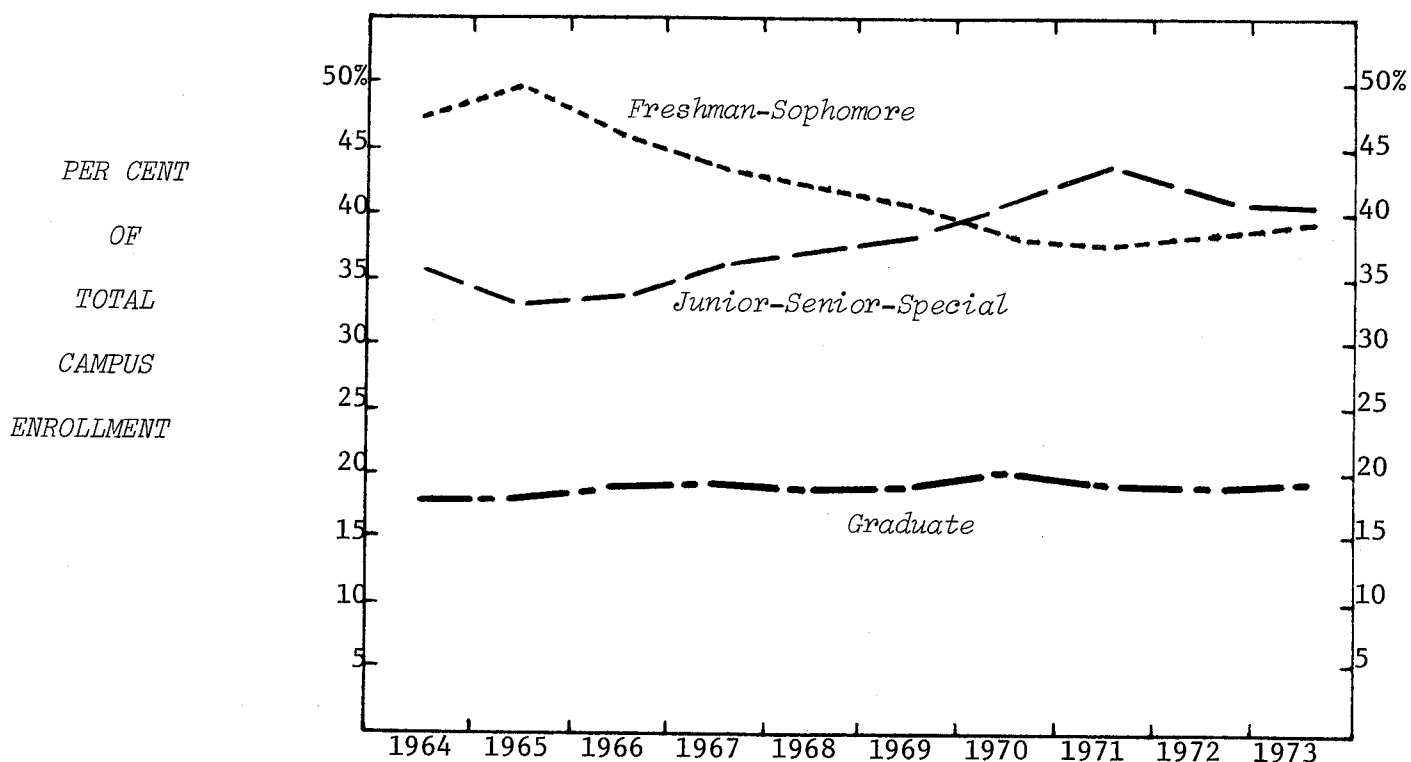

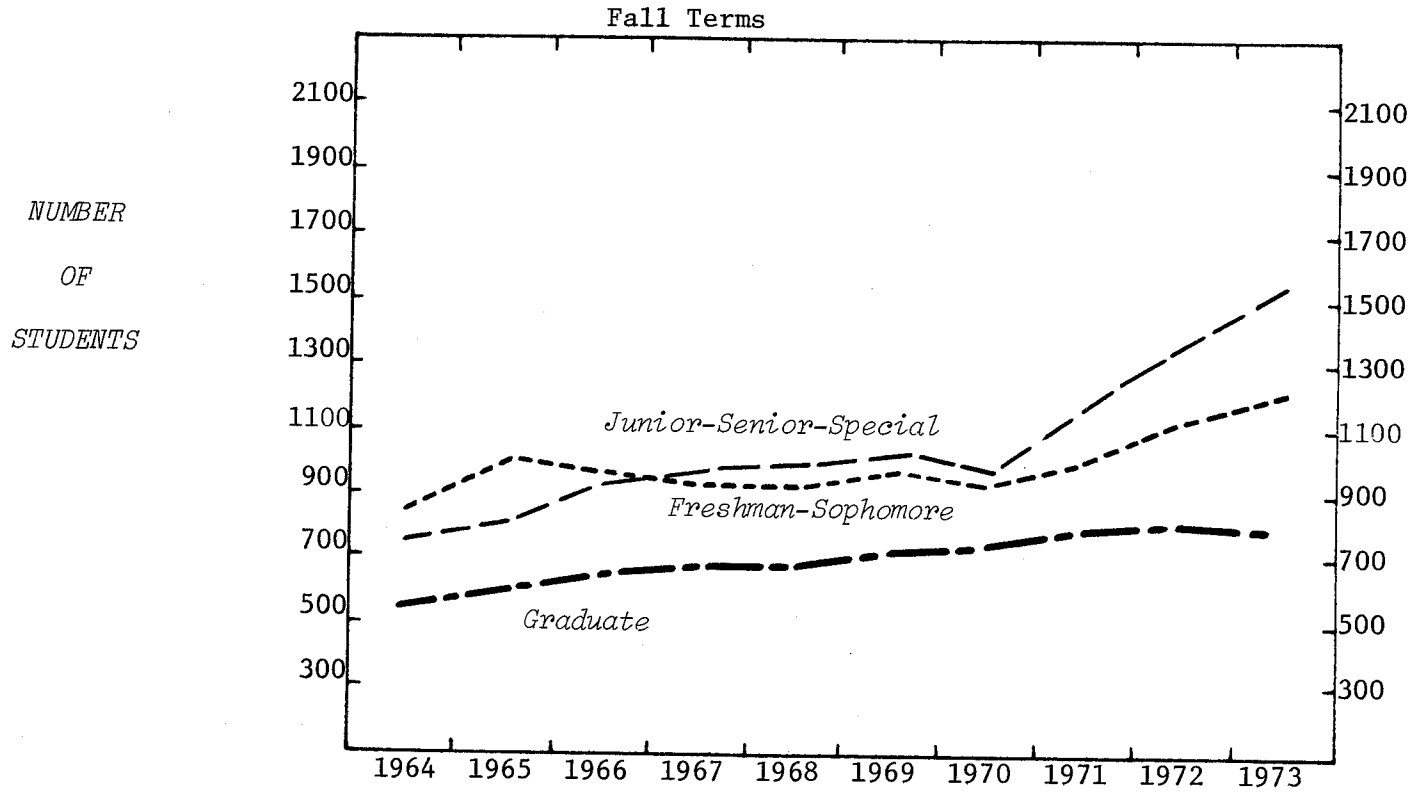

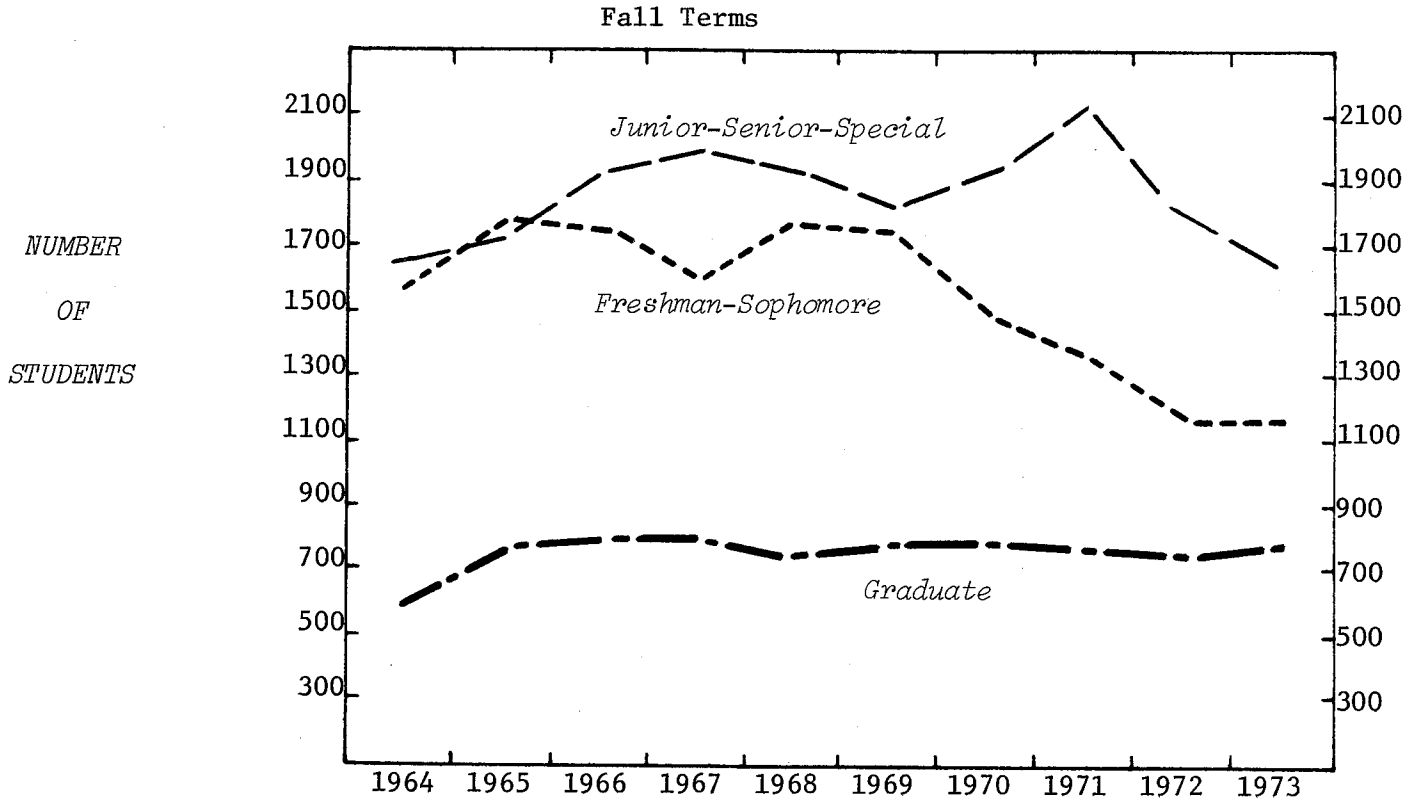
