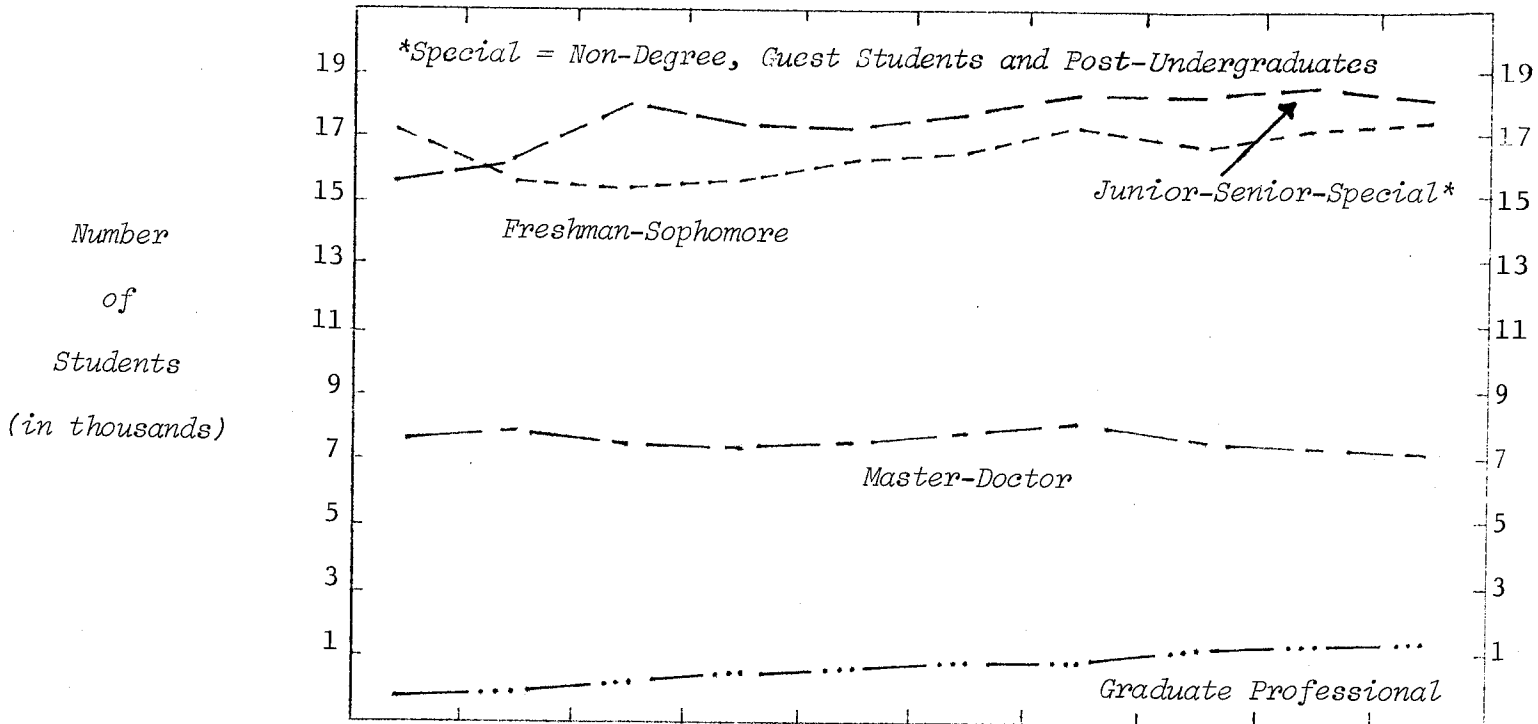

Fall Terms



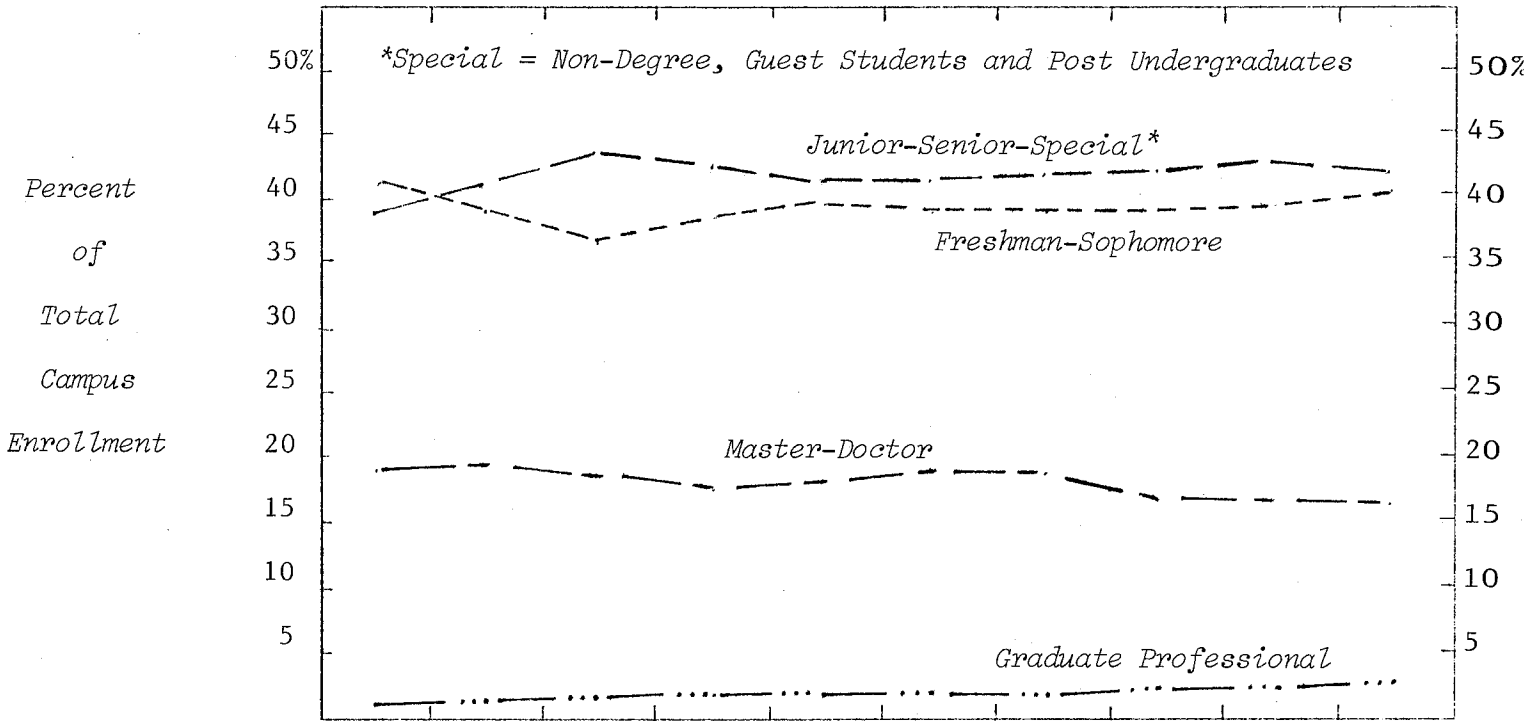
