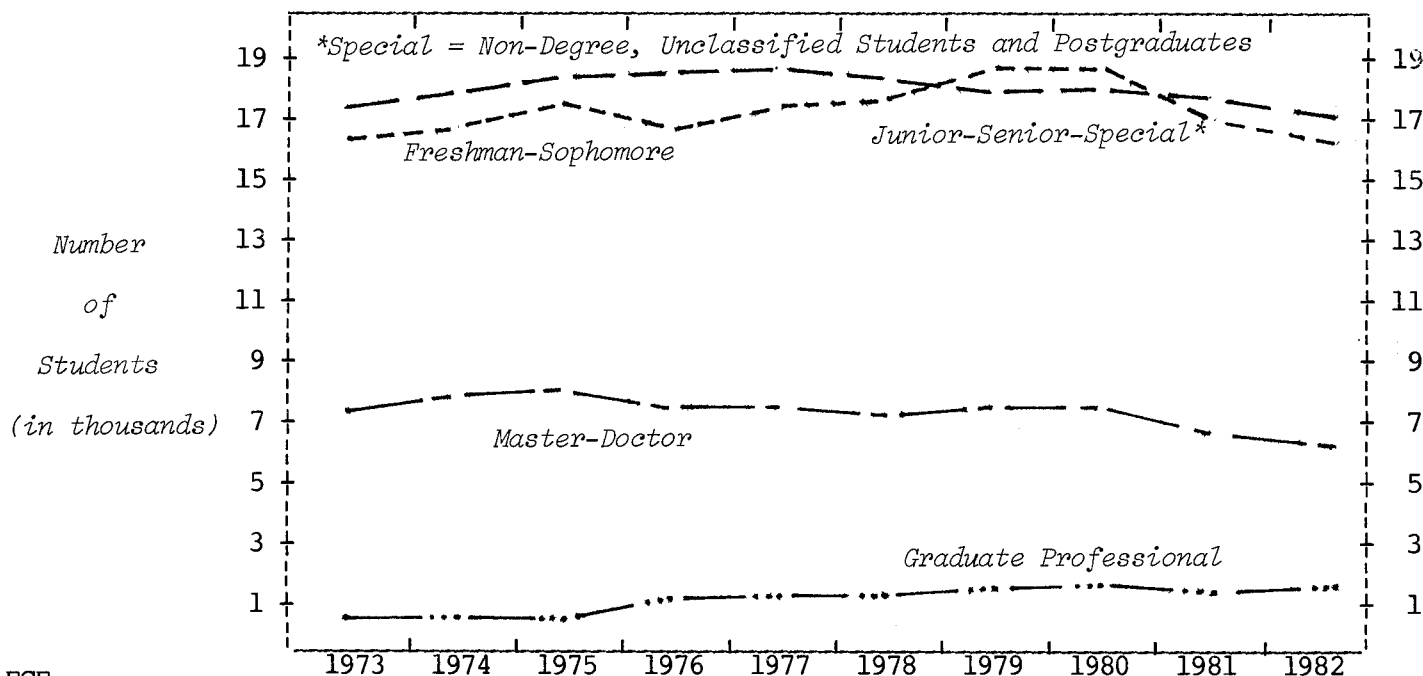

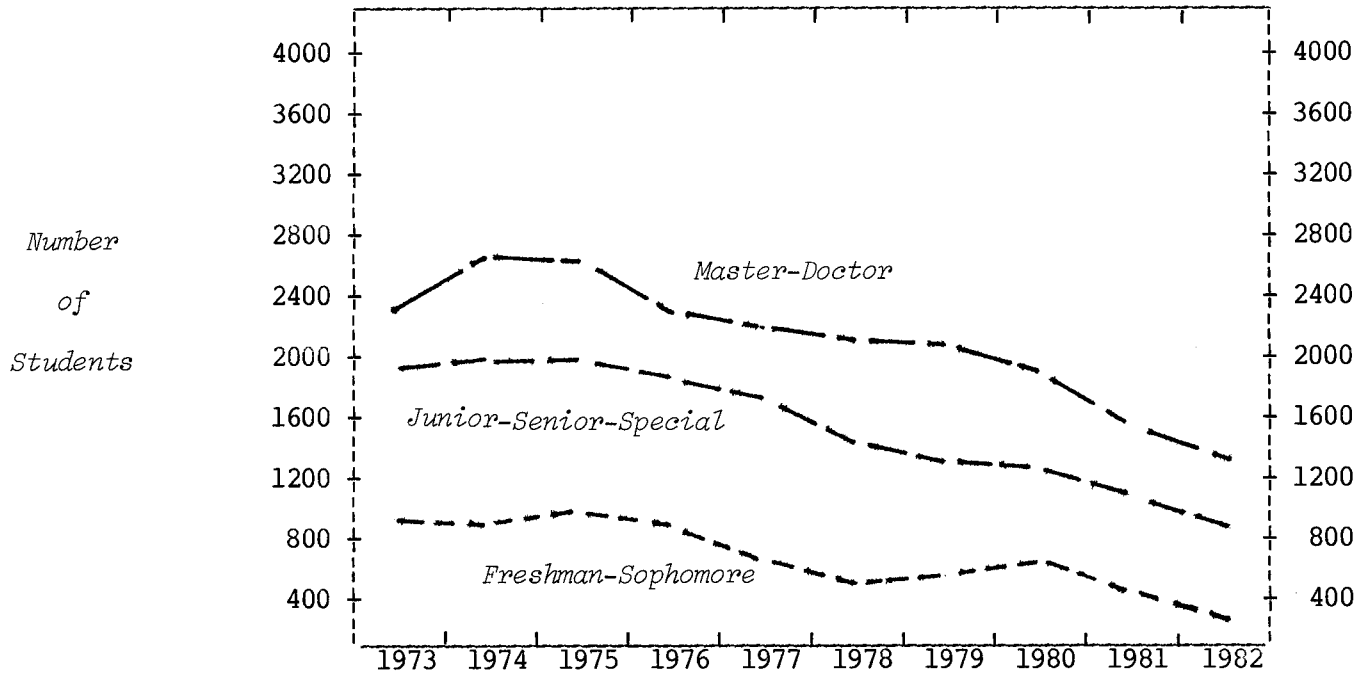

HIGHLIGHTS

The total number of students enrolled Fall 1982 as of one-tenth of the term is 40,627, a decrease of 1,467 or 3.5% from Fall 1981.

The total number of credit hours for Fall 1982 generated by these students was less than Fall 1981 by 22,973, or a decrease of 4.2%.

The College of Education with a loss of 672 students or 21.7% from Fall 1981 showed the largest actual and percentage decrease in students (445 fewer undergraduates and 227 fewer graduates). The College of Communication Arts and Sciences with a gain of 452 students or 13.7% from Fall 1981 showed the largest actual and percentage increase in students (403 more undergraduates and 49 more graduates).

New students increased 243 over Fall 1981 which included 114 more undergraduate transfer students and 60 more new graduate professional students. First-time degree program freshmen increased two students. New graduate students decreased 52 students.

Readmitted students showed a 6.0% decrease or 106 less students than in Fall 1981. There was also a decrease of 5.3% in returning students with 1,604 fewer students than in Fall 1981. Returning student rates were relatively stable, however, the decreasing student population produced a reduction in actual numbers.

Female students showed a loss of 878 students or a 4.3% decrease, while male students dropped 589 or a decrease of 2.7%. Female students account for 48.4% of the total student enrollment and 53.3% of the First-time freshmen enrollment (includes Agricultural Technology).

Married students decreased by 726 or 24.4%.

The decrease in total graduate students was less in Fall 1982 (79 students, decrease 1.2%) than was shown for Fall 1981 (7.9%).

Fall 1982 credit hour figures reflect the transfer of Lyman Briggs School, the undergraduate Medical Technology program, and the Improvement Service course to the College of Natural Science. Courses in Urban Affairs Programs were discontinued as of Fall 1982.
