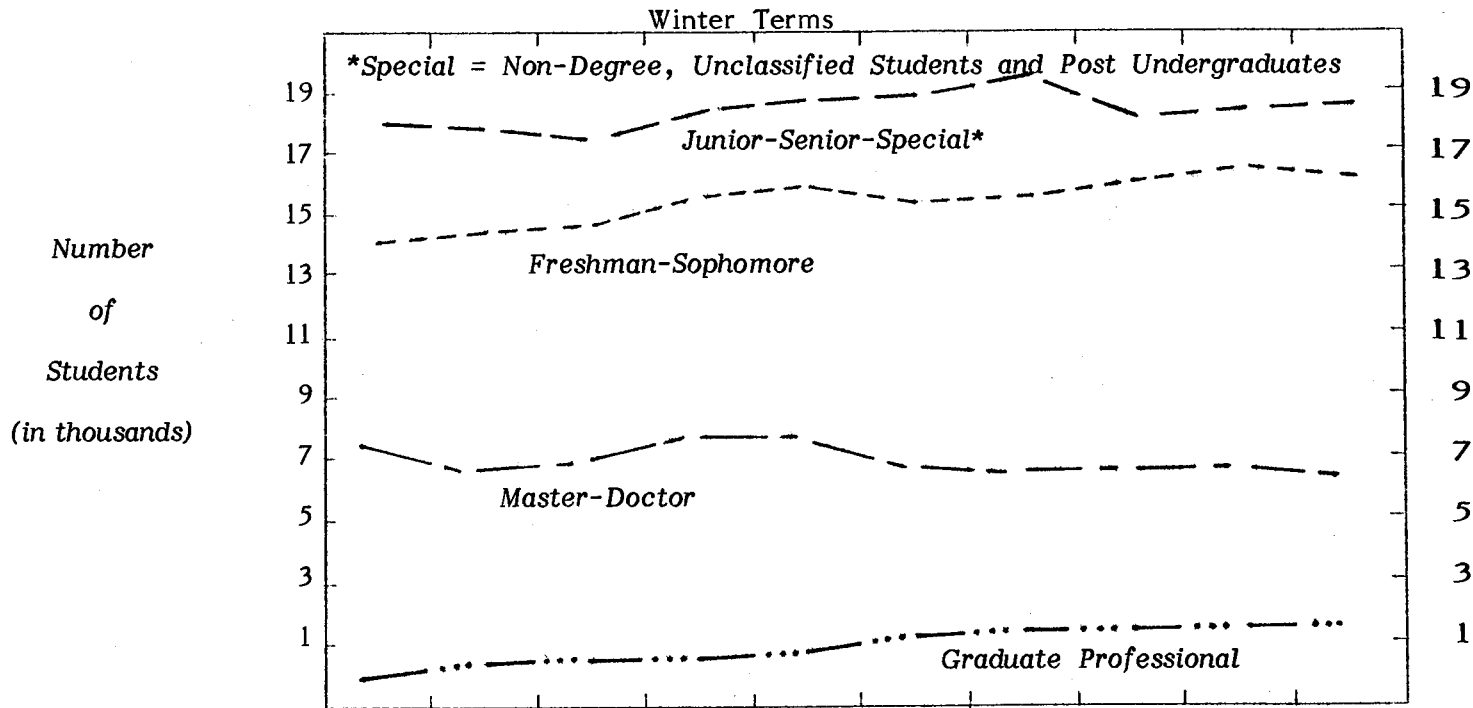

East Lansing Campus



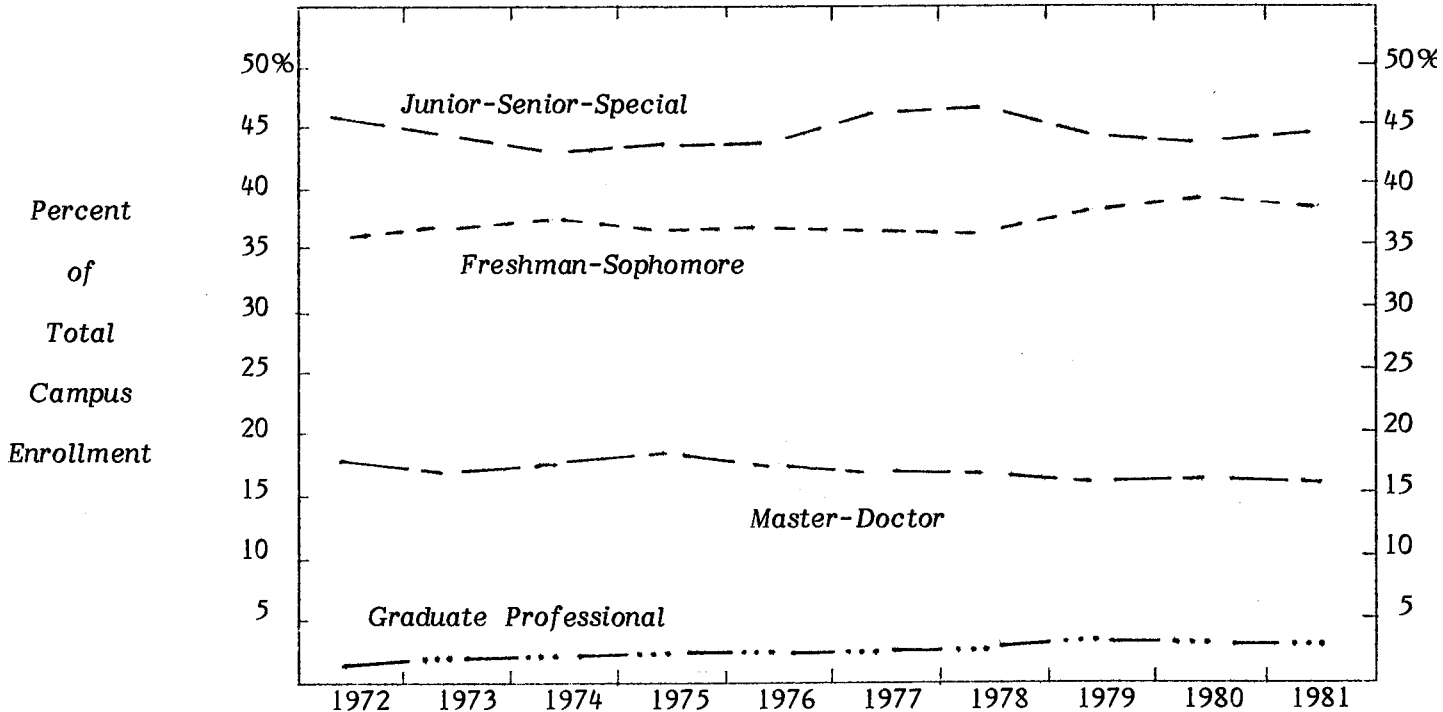

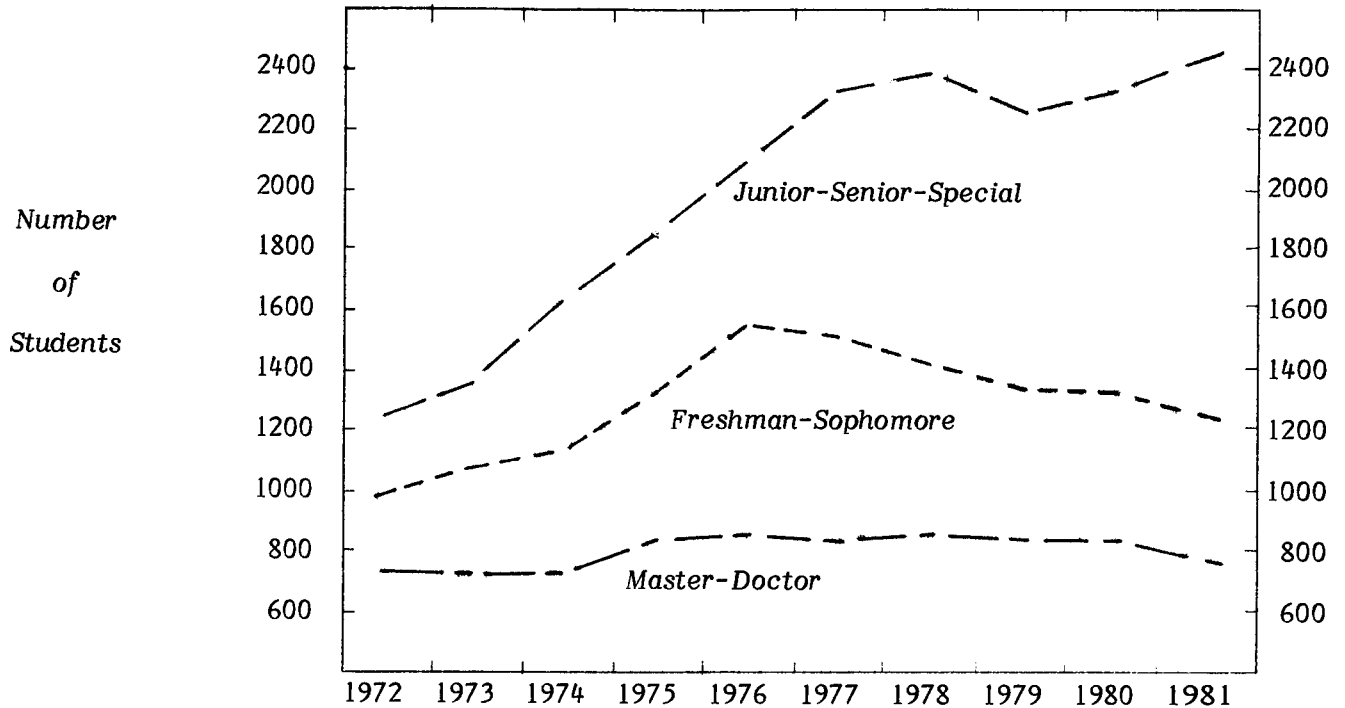
