Other academic information:

Fall Semester: Late August to late December (17 weeks)

Spring semester: Mid-January to mid-May with a one-week break near Easter (17 weeks)

Summer: Late May to late July (8 weeks)

Each student will be required to enroll for a minimum of twelve (12) credits per semester. Most courses are equivalent to 3 MSU credits. Participants need to have completed Spanish 202, or the equivalent. Spanish majors and minors must have completed Spanish 310 or its equivalent. Students may choose courses from a wide variety of courses in arts and letters, business, natural science, and the social sciences.
