## Other academic information:

John Cabot University is an independent, four-year accredited institution of liberal arts and sciences offering an American undergraduate university education. JCU is incorporated as a not-for-profit organization in the State of Delaware and is licensed to award its degrees by the Delaware Department of Education. All courses, except Italian language classes and literature, are taught in English, and follow the traditional U.S. university specifications on a semester system.

Generally, courses at John Cabot University carry three units of credit. The academic year is divided into two semesters of fifteen weeks each, beginning in September and January. In one semester, a student normally enrolls in four to five courses, earning 13 - 16 credits in the semester and 30 credits in the year. Two summer sessions of five weeks each allows students to take one or two additional courses.

Second semester Late January to mid-May

Summer sessions Late May to late June; early July to early August
