## Other academic information:

University of Melbourne is an accredited four-year institution.

Semester 2	Late July through late November	
Academic year	Late February through late November	

The semester has 12 weeks of instruction, a one (Semester 1) or two (Semester 2)-week break and three weeks of exams. A "subject" is comparable to an MSU "course". A full subject load is 50 (12.5 points x 3 subjects) points for one semester. Study abroad students are encouraged to take subjects from up to four faculties ("colleges"). Students are required to take a minimum of three courses and no more than four sources.

Coursework at the University of Melbourne is available in the following colleges: Architecture, Building and Planning; Arts (Anthropology, Art History, Archaeology, Australian Studies, English, Criminology, Sociology, etc); Economics and Commerce; Education; Engineering; Land and Food Resources; Law; Music; and Science.

As the majority of University of Melbourne degrees are 3 years in duration, the level of units is 100 (1<sup>st</sup> year), 200 (2<sup>nd</sup> year) and 300 (3<sup>rd</sup> year), which generally equate with 200, 300, and 400 level US units. Most study abroad students enroll in 100 or 200 level units. Graduate level units are generally labeled as 800.
