Other academic information:

The American College of Thessaloniki (ACT), a division of Anatolia in Thessaloniki, Greece, is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges through its Commission on Institutions of Higher Education. Accreditation by the New England Association is not partial but applies to the institution as a whole. ACT utilizes the 4 point grading scale as in the United States.

In addition to the standard letter grading system, a Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grade option is available for Study Abroad students; An "S" grade corresponds to a letter grade of at least a C.

Students studying full time at the American College of Thessaloniki are required to take four courses valued at 3 U.S. semester credits each for a total of 12 credits.

The academic year is divided into two semesters of fifteen weeks each, beginning in September and February. In one semester, a student normally enrolls in four to five courses, earning 12 - 15 credits in the semester and 24-30 credits in the year.
